Designed To Perform

The Monterey hull has a fine entry, designed to slice though sloppy water. The hull flattens out to a smooth riding deadrise at the transom of 19°. Strategically positioned lifting strakes, two either side of the keel, aid quick planing and ensure a dry ride.

In side profile the Monterey boasts exceptional freeboard, essential for safe family boating, flowing seaworthy lines and a stylish Euro transom design.

Interior Made For Family Comfort

The Whittley Monterey pioneered a unique "flow through" cockpit design system. Through innovative design work, the conventional step-down into the cabin from the cockpit has been eliminated.

By virtue of a gracious downward sweep of the floor line, you can move from the cockpit to the cabin without having to trip down any steps. The free flowing, clean lines of the interior are achieved by the use of a precision fibreglass moulded cockpit liner.

The Monterey cabin sets the standard for exceptional use of space and quality of soft furnishings. By day the cabin provides exceptional shelter from the elements. And by night, in-fill cushions slot into the walk-through to form an enormous bed.

Amazing as it may seem, contained within the Whittley Monterey is a sink, stove, portable toilet, ice chest, pressurised water system, hand held shower, teak table and enough storage for a family weekend on the water.

Adults who enjoy a piping hot drink while on board need only hinge forward the passenger's seat to reveal a single burner butane stove. And when it's time to tidy up and clean away the dishes, they can be washed in the sink under the skipper's seat. The sink is even plumbed with a pressurised water system.





From Open Day Boat To Camper

Versatility is a strength of the Whittley Monterey. Under sunny skies, the openness of the Monterey allows true fun in the sun, whether you are cruising new waters, fishing or water skiing.

By snapping into position the full set of camper covers (included in the standard inventory of every Whittley Monterey), the craft is instantly converted into a floating covers for total privacy and seclusion.

The teak companionway doors can be left open so that the cockpit and cabin flow into one. Or if privacy is needed, the doors can be closed to separate the cockpit from the cabin.
